**SAGAMORE HILLS TOWNSHIP
AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION 149-79**

RESOLUTION introduced by John Zaccardelli.
AMENDMENT introduced by Paul Schweikert.

WHEREAS, Section 505.17 of the Ohio Revised Code gives authority to the Board of Township Trustees to enact parking regulations, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable to restrict or eliminate parking on the Township roads to promote the general safety and welfare of the residents of the Township in general snow-emergency events; and

WHEREAS, Sagamore Hills Township has adopted a snow ban on all Township roads in Sagamore Hills pursuant to Resolution 149-79 adopted and wishes to update said Resolution; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Sagamore Hills Township pursuant to Section 505.17 authorizes the Chair of the Board or their designee to issue an Order to declaring a snow emergency and limiting or prohibiting parking on any Township streets or highway during the snow emergency when snow exceeds or is expected to exceed two inches (2") in height. This Amended Resolution shall be posted in five (5) conspicuous places, and be published in the newspaper of general circulation for three consecutive weeks.

1. Parking during a snow emergency, as defined herein, upon any township street on which traffic control devices are displayed in accordance with paragraph 3 of this Resolution, is prohibited. Such traffic control devices shall be erected at locations determined by the Township Road Superintendent. For purposes of this Resolution a snow emergency is hereby defined as a condition existing in all or part of the township whereby snow has accumulated to a depth of two or more inches upon township streets and creates a condition requiring snow removal or treatment by township trucks, plows or other vehicles.
2. The provisions of this Resolution shall be in effect from and after two hours following the declaring of a snow emergency by the Township Road Superintendent or by the Chair of the Township Board of Trustees, and by the making of an announcement of such emergency to the local news media, requesting that the local news media announce that such an emergency has been declared, specifying the hour the declaration will go into effect, and indicating whether the snow emergency will remain in effect for a specified period of time or indefinitely until cancelled by a subsequent announcement to the local news media by the Road Superintendent or Chair of the Township Board of Trustees.
3. Traffic control devices conforming to Section 4511.09 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be prominently displayed for purposes of enforcing the provisions of this Resolution.
4. Upon adoption of this Resolution, a copy of the Resolution shall be posted by the Township Clerk in five conspicuous places in the township for a period of thirty (30) days, and a copy of this Resolution shall be published in newspaper of general circulation in the township for three consecutive weeks. Permanent signs giving notice that parking is limited or prohibited during a snow emergency shall be properly posted, in accordance with any applicable standards adopted by the Ohio Department of Transportation, along streets described in this Resolution.
5. The Township Road Superintendent or Chair of the Township Board of Trustees may order into storage any vehicle parked in violation of this Resolution. The owner or any lienholder of a vehicle ordered into storage may claim the vehicle upon presentation of proof of ownership, which may be evidenced by a certificate of title to a vehicle, and payment of all expenses, charges and fines incurred as a result of the parking violation and removal and storage of the vehicle.

6. Whoever violates any regulation or order adopted pursuant to this Resolution is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. Fines levied and collected shall be paid into the Township General Revenue Fund.

This Resolution to take effect in accordance with the provisions of Section 505.17 and be subject to the limitations, restrictions, and exceptions of Section 4511.01,4511.76, 4513.02 and 4513.37.
