

## Open Doors - Palmer House History Revisited

The Palmer House Museum is participating in an Open Doors program sponsored by the Ohio History Connection. Open Doors is a statewide event where building and landmark owners open their doors to the public for special tours and programs. The Palmer House Museum is housed in one of the few vertical beam construction houses still in use today and is run by The Historical Society of Old Northfield.

Museum tours will be self-guided and will highlight local Nordonia Hills history, early life furniture and artifacts, farm equipment, and

a Fenton glassware display.
