Starting April 1, 2021 and finishing by May 5, 2021, the Eaton Estate Homeowners Association will be doing a wetland restoration project on the Seiberling Drive known as the forebay project. This project will involve the removal of approximately 150 trucks of dirt representing about 2,000 cubic yards. The project will restore the wetland area and is being monitored by Summit Soil and Water Conservation District and with appropriate permitting from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and with a US Army Corps of Engineers. Work will generally be conducted from 8 am until 5 pm each weekday during this period. Traffic may be slowed in the area as trucks remove this material which will be hauled to Valley View, Ohio.
